Auckland – a beautiful harbour city with a distinctly Pacific flavour. Activities: Sailing in the Hauraki Gulf, Americas Cup Village, Kelly Tarlton's Underwater World, Museum, Zoo, Waiheke Island by boat or helicopter, trips to the Kauri forests, wineries, shopping and excellent restaurants.

Tairua – A small coastal resort town with a holiday atmosphere. Activities: Hot Water Beach, Hahei, Cathedral Cove, Bush Walks, golf, fishing and boat trips, swimming, picnicking, artists and craftspeople

Auckland to Tairua
165 km / 103 miles 2 hours

Taupo – New Zealand's largest lake is set against a backdrop of volcanic mountains and central to the geothermal regions. Activities: world class fishing, golf, trekking and bush walks, boating, White Island flights, geothermal sites, Maori culture.

Tairua to Taupo
260 km / 162 miles 5 hours

Motueka – An ideal base from which to explore the Abel Tasman National Park and the Nelson/Tasman Bay area. Activities: Trout fishing, walks, swimming, sea kayaking, boat trips, wineries, art and craft galleries, markets, great cafes.

Nelson to Motueka
47 km / 30 miles .75 hour

Fly Rotorua to Nelson, via Wellington 2.5 hours

Queenstown – A pretty lakeside alpine town set against a backdrop of steep snow clad mountains and known as the adventure and adrenalin capital. Activities: A cruise on the lake and visit to a high country station, helicopter flights to Fiordland including Milford and Doubtful Sounds, jet boating, horse trekking, rafting, bungy-jumping, parachuting and lots of great restaurants and shopping.

Fly Nelson to Queenstown, via Christchurch 2.5 hours

Christchurch – Known as the Garden City and the major arrival and departure flight for international flights in the South Island. Activities: Parks and gardens, Antarctic Centre, Arts Centre and Galleries, punting on the Avon River, Mona Vale, beaches, Akaroa, Kaikoura and Hanmer Springs day trips, swimming with the dolphins and Whale Watching, wineries.

Dunedin to Christchurch
365 km / 228 miles 4.75 hours

Queenstown to Dunedin
280 km / 175 miles 3.5 hours

Dunedin – This Southern city is a University town with strong links to its Scottish heritage. Activities: Wildlife Tours including Royal Albatross colony and Yellow Eyed Penguins, Larnachs Castle, Brighton Beach, parks and gardens, shopping and restaurants
